DISCUSSED Urges the Governor, State Legislature and Arizona Congressional Delegation to support federal funding for Arizona's ports of entry including the expansion of and improvement of all forms of federal, state and local facilities and infrastructure related to the trade into and out of the ports of entry in the State of Arizona.
