CONTINUANCES

- A. **GP2008-014:** This is a request by the City of Yuma to amend the Bicycle Facilities Master Plan. This policy document provides a current inventory of existing facilities, an analysis of bicycle facility needs, and a guide for bicycle facility planning and education. The update will amend the 1995 bicycle facilities plan and is the result of significant changes in the development patterns of Yuma and the increased public interest in bicycle facilities as a method for transportation. *(Continued to the meeting of March 9, 2009)*
- B. **S2008-009:** This is a request by Dahl, Robins and Associates, on behalf of LEEP, LLC, for approval of the preliminary plat for the Eagle 20 Subdivision. This subdivision will contain approximately 19.92 acres and is proposed to be divided into 23 residential lots, ranging in size from approximately 21,367 square feet to 50,953 square feet. The property is located at the southwest corner of Avenue C and the 36th Street alignment, Yuma, AZ. *(Continued to the meeting of March 9, 2009)*
- C. **Z2008-022:** This is a request by the City of Yuma to rezone three (3) adjacent parcels totaling approximately 114.8 acres from the Recreational Vehicle Subdivision (RVS) District and the Agriculture District to the Agriculture / Public Designation (AG/P) District. The properties are located on the southeast corner of 34th Street and Avenue 6 E, Yuma, AZ. *(Continued to the meeting of March 9, 2009)*
- D. **Z2008-023:** This is a request by City of Yuma, on behalf of William Thacker, to rezone two (2) adjacent parcels totaling approximately 1.5 acres from the Agriculture (AG) District to the Residential Estate (RE-18) District. The property is located at 4450 W. 8th Street, Yuma, AZ. *(Continued to the meeting of March 9, 2009)*
- E. **Z2009-004:** This is a request by the City of Yuma for a Zoning Code Text Amendment to amend Title 15, Chapter 154, Section 008 (A) by adding the following text: “(6) Determine other permitted uses consistent with the purpose of each Zoning District.” *(Continued to the meeting of March 9, 2009)*

- 1. **GP2008-013:** This is a General Plan Amendment request by Wayne Benesch, Esq., on behalf of Tanimura & Associates General Partnership, Laurel Properties, LLC, and La Mesa Ranch, LLC, to change the land use designations from High Density Residential, Mixed Use and Public/Quasi-Public to Medium Density Residential for three properties. The properties total approximately 240 acres. The requested land use change is generally located south of 24th Street, north of the Gila Main Canal, east of the Ave 4 5/8 E alignment and west of the Avenue 6 1/8 E alignment. *(2nd of 2 public hearings)*

- 2. **208-003:** This is a request by Jesus C. and Jennie Landeros for abandonment of 500 square feet of right-of-way located in the alley behind 545 S. 1st Avenue, Yuma, AZ. *(Continued from the meeting of February 9, 2009)*
