Purpose: Revitalize Yuma one neighborhood at a time.

Plan:

- Locate neighborhood volunteers who share a vision of a cleaner and more attractive Yuma.
- Provide logistical support to these volunteers.
- Assist these community members in sharing that vision with their neighbors.
- Organize additional labor volunteers for these members.
- Assist with cleanup and removal of "eye-sores."



Outcomes:

- Neighbors introduce and reintroduce themselves to one another.
- Participants receive "local" help to accomplish the troublesome tasks.
- Participants develop long range visions for the neighborhood.
- Participants receive neighborhood praise for their efforts.
- Participants renew their pride in their neighborhood.

TO DO LIST

GETTING STARTED

- Find a co-captain
- Pick a date to start hanging door flyers.
- Identify the following Saturday as the day to hold the informational meeting.
- Identify a date at least two weeks later for the actual cleanup

TELL the Clean and Beautiful Commission about your plans.

- Notify the Clean and Beautiful Commission of your dates.
- C&B will contact additional volunteers to ensure there will be sufficient participants.
- C&B will provide you with the door hangers and the door flyers and "Hello. My name is" badges."

INFORMATIONAL MEETING

- C&B will come to assist with the informational meeting and the refreshments.
- Hold the informational meeting.
- Log homes contacted and homes that will be participating.
- Notify the Clean and Beautiful Commission once you have a guaranteed 10 homes signed up to participate.
- Collect requested work sheets. Discuss problems with C&B personnel.

CLEANUP DAY

- Check off volunteers. Add additional volunteers with name and address (for thank you notes)
- Log equipment
- Organize work crews and give each crew the paperwork for WORK REQUESTED.
- Distribute additional bags to each work site.
- Periodically check workers for hydration. Distribute water as needed.

AFTER THE CLEANUP

- Make sure all debris is put into the dumpster
- Make sure all tools are picked up.
- Make sure all volunteers are listed on your volunteer sheets.
- Complete thank you notes.
- Give notes to C&B commissioner to mail.





Neighbors Helping Neighbors General Guidelines

Power Tools should only be operated by the owner of the tools. Under no circumstances should one of the minors be permitted to use the tools.

You and your neighbors will supply line trimmers and other “power” tools and extension cords.
