**Summary of Current Events:** Martin Agundez reported on the Adopt-a-Street Program, Household Hazardous Waste and the Neighborhood Cleanup.

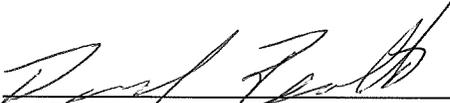
