

APPLICATIONS TO BE CONSIDERED

1. **VAR-14664-2016:** This is a request by SignMasters LLC, on behalf of Awars LTD, LLC, for a variance within the Transitional (TR) zoning district to increase the allowable sign face area for a free-standing sign from 24 square feet to 73 square feet and to increase the permitted sign height within the front setback from 4 feet to 16 feet. The property is located at 2051 W 25th Street, Yuma, AZ.
2. **VAR-14704-2016:** This is a request by Penn Neon Sign Company, Inc., on behalf of The Salvation Army, for a variance to increase the amount of allowable signage from 24 square feet to 125 square feet, allow more than one sign per street frontage, allow the maximum area of signs to be more than 24 square feet per sign, and allow a 6' high sign within the street setback, in the Low Density Residential (R-1-6) District. The property is located at 1100 S. 13th Avenue, Yuma, AZ.
