

Registration Information

OUR MISSION:

Enriching lives through quality programs, experiences, and facilities that preserve the past, provide for the present, plan for the future, and promote the spirit of fun.

This Fall and Winter, Yuma Parks and Recreation is offering a variety of opportunities for all ages through recreational programming, classes, and activities, while striving to provide excellent customer satisfaction at every level.

PROGRAM REGISTRATION:

Program priority registration will be held beginning Monday, August 22, 2016 for City of Yuma residents and Monday, August 29, 2016 for all other residents, and will continue throughout the Fall and Winter season. On-line registration will begin on Monday, August 29, 2016 for programs not requiring a birth certificate/registration form. Some programs are limited to the number of participants and will close when a program fills. If a class or program you are interested in is full, please ask to be put on a "wait list". Wait lists will be used should vacancies occur or class expansion is feasible. Various program fees are discounted for qualifying City of Yuma residents. For the purpose of registration, a Yuma resident is defined as any person living within the corporate limits of the City of Yuma.

CHILDREN'S AGE REQUIREMENTS:

Age requirements are established to safely facilitate age appropriate classes. Children must be the appropriate age by the first day of class or date specified in order to register – no exceptions.

SIX EASY WAYS TO REGISTER:

Registration forms are available in the Parks and Recreation Office and on the City of Yuma website: yumaaz.gov/parksandrec.

Online registration at yumaaz.gov/parksandrec (Some programs are not available for online registration.) Please verify your online profile information when registering.

Walk-In registration is available from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday thru Thursday and 7:00 am to 5:00 pm every other Friday at Yuma City Hall, One City Plaza. (City Hall is closed on alternate Fridays.)

Registration may also be taken at the Yuma Readiness and Community Center, as well as at the North End Community Center.

Fax-In registration forms 24 hours a day to (928) 373-5244, then pay over the phone using MasterCard, Discover, Visa, or American Express.

Mail-In registration to Yuma Parks and Recreation, One City Plaza, Yuma, Arizona, 85364.

Phone-In registration using MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express. Our phone line is (928) 373-5200. This option is not available when a registration form is required. **Walk-in registration will have priority, and you may be placed on hold or asked to have your call returned based on the volume of customers waiting in line at the time.

After Hours drop off registration is available by using the slot at the front of Yuma City Hall, One City Plaza.

CONSIDER YOUR SCHEDULE CAREFULLY BEFORE REGISTERING

We encourage registrants to consider their schedule carefully prior to registering for any program or class offered. A refund, less \$5 of the fee, may be requested prior to the start of the program. No refunds for swim lessons. After the program starts, refunds will not be considered. No cash refunds will be issued. Refunds will be processed within 10 business days.

We reserve the right to cancel classes/programs due to insufficient registration or other causes beyond our control. A minimum of 8 participants is required for programs and classes.

Fees, dates, and times are subject to change.

We reserve the right to photograph facilities, activities, and program participants for potential future use in advertising. All photos will remain the property of the City of Yuma.

Some programs will not be held on City recognized holidays. In addition, there are dates that programs will not be scheduled due to other special events.

Open Water Scuba Diving


