### Art in the Park: Saturday, January 13, 2017, 12 noon – 5:00 pm in Gateway Park, Yuma, AZ

Art in the Park is a fine arts festival inspired by the infamous “Sunday in the Park on the Island of La Grande Jatte” by Georges Seurat. This one day event takes place along the meandering Colorado River in Downtown Yuma. As they chat with artists and select their favorite works, art patrons are invited to sip a mimosa and stroll along the river.

**About Yuma:** Yuma is home to nearly 100,000 residents and that number more than doubles each winter with seasonal visitors. Just a few hours from many major US cities, Yuma is an oasis for arts and culture and has seen a significant boost in tourism in the last decade. Yuma is nationally recognized for its rich cultural history and is home to many arts organizations, including the Yuma Art Center which is home to the City of Yuma’s Arts and Culture Division.

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**Terms and Conditions:**

1. Only exhibitors displaying their own original work may participate. No stand-in or proxy exhibitors will be allowed to represent the artist.
2. All works of art must be the exhibitor's own original ideas and assembly. All artwork must be original or printed of the exhibitor's original work. Manufactured or commercially produced works are not permitted. All items to be sold at booth must be indicated on application. The City of Yuma will not be held responsible for any type of copyright infringement.
3. Limit 2 artists per 10 x 10 booth space. Applications and full fees must be received from both artists and both artists must pass the jury selection. Both artists must list the other artist on their application. Special consideration may be made for student or school groups.
4. Exhibitor must provide their own tent, chairs, displays, tables and any other necessary equipment. A limited number of tents are available for rent.
5. Electricity is not available at Gateway Park. Any electrical needs must be discussed with the event coordinator prior to the event and will be at the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.
6. Sales Tax: the exhibitor is responsible for collecting and remitting all sales tax.
7. Booth space must be manned and open for the duration of the event. Booths must be ready a minimum of one hour prior to the event opening and must remain open until the event closing time. Vehicles are allowed only during designated times and must follow directional rules as indicated in acceptance packets.
8. All booth placements are determined by the event coordinator. We will make every effort to accommodate special requests, but cannot guarantee specific placement.
9. Only artwork may be presented in exhibitor booths. Food and beverage items are restricted to food vendors only.
10. Music will be provided by the Yuma Art Center. Please refrain from having music or sound equipment in your booth unless otherwise discussed with the event coordinator.
11. Marketing and Promotions: By participating in Art in the Park and/or ARTbeat 10, Exhibitor agrees to have Exhibitor's name and photographs of their work(s) reproduced for publicity, promotional and educational uses.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their booth area during and at the close of the event.
13. Payment problems with checks and/or credit cards will result in restriction to cash or money order payment for future shows. There will be a fee of \$45 for returned checks.
14. This is a "rain-or-shine" event and will occur on the scheduled date regardless of weather.
15. Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages by exhibitors and/or workers are prohibited. Exhibitors will be held responsible for any violations.
16. Insurance: The City of Yuma does not carry any insurance for any perils whatsoever against Exhibitor's Work and assume no responsibility for any damages to Work and the Work's supporting materials incurred before, during, or after the event(s). Exhibitor understands and agrees that Exhibitor's Work(s) is exhibited at Exhibitor's own risk.
17. The sponsors of this event will not be liable for any liabilities whatsoever for the failure to fulfill conditions under which the event is being produced: due to natural causes, act of God, or any other causes beyond the control of the City of Yuma.
18. The City of Yuma is not responsible for the security of individual booths. Exhibitors are responsible to secure their own booths, supplies and equipment.

**The City of Yuma Division of Arts and Culture reserves the right to refuse entrance to any said event. Exhibitors will be notified upon acceptance to each event.**
