## COMMUNITY PERFORMANCE FESTIVAL RULES

**What is required to participate?** A completed Community Performance Application on file and insurance if your performance is considered high risk by our risk management department. We encourage you to purchase a vendor business booth to help boost your recognition at the event. Advertisements are also available for purchase in the event program. You must return completed and signed application by **Friday, September 2, 2016 at 5:30 p.m.** to be scheduled as a festival performer. Your group **MUST** attend the pre-festival vendor, sponsor and performer meeting scheduled at the Yuma Civic Center on **Thursday, September 8, 2016 at 2 p.m.**

**Who may enter?** Any amateur or professional company or group is eligible to apply as a festival performer, if culturally appropriate.

**What can be entered?** A performance entered in the street fair may be a performance of a theatrical nature, musicians, mariachis, dancers or other culturally appropriate performances.

**What do the festival organizers provide?** A designated performance stage (32'x40') with basic sound and mic equipment will be provided in the Civic Center. If appropriate, you may also be allowed to crowd surf in the street fair festival area.

**What Do I need to provide?** If your performance requires music you **MUST** present your soundtrack on a thumb drive or CD to the festival DJ to have on file to cue when you perform. Sound Checks may be arranged before the festival begins between **12 p.m. to 3 p.m.** If your performance requires additional microphones, props, music holders or any other specialty equipment you must have it present and prepared for performance 5 minutes before your set begins.

### General Information:

- Stage rehearsals will be conducted at noon on the day of the festival
- Venue gates open at 5:00 PM
- Changing rooms are not available (Come ready to perform!)
- Rain or Shine event
- Line Up / Set times subject to change
- Everyone subject to search upon entry
- The festival is all ages
- The festival is free to the community
- Parking is Free
- Performance is Free (Donation requests are allowed)

### Not Allowed:

- No weapons of any kind
- No glass
- No underage drinking
- No illegal substances
- No pets (accept assistance animals)
- No use of unauthorized golf carts or ATVs
- NO LITTERING
- No coolers in the festival grounds (except for vendors)
- Outside food/drink
