Led Streetlight Conversion Update: Martin Agundez had Pete Montalvo talk about the LED streetlights, there are 2,010 out of 7,000 poles installed, starting with residential then businesses. With Completion by January 2019.

Household Hazardous Waste Day Update: Joe Lopez wants to bring Household Hazardous Waste back to the Public Works building, away from the Civic Center. Showed to different maps for entrance and exits for the customers. 448 cars, 24 volunteers, 55-55 gallon drums, 440 used oil, 110 gallons used anti-freeze, 110 gallons of water based paint, 180 gallons recycle paper, 116 tires, 2.25 tons of trash, 8 yard of recycle, 35 yards of e-waste.
