

PUBLIC NOTICE



The City of Yuma is accepting citizen input and public comments concerning an Amendment to the 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan and the 2019/2020 Annual Action Plan. The City of Yuma will receive \$505,565 in CDBG funding for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act). The funds are to be used to address needs created by the COVID-19 virus. Based on the guidance of health officials concerning the COVID-19 virus, the COY will not conduct an in-person public hearing on the Amendments but will receive and respond to all public input by telephone and email.

2016-2020 Consolidated Plan Amendment: Emergency, Short-term Rental Assistance Program for low-and moderate-income people and public services to address needs created by the COVID-19 Virus were both added as funding priorities in the Consolidated Plan. .

2019-2020 Annual Action Plan Amendment: The City of Yuma will allocate all \$505,565 in Community Development Block Grant CARES funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as outlined below. These CDBG funds can only be utilized in the city of Yuma limits.

The Annual Action Plan (AAP) refers primarily to the housing and community development needs and intended uses of CDBG resources. The proposed Amendment to the 2019-2020 AAP is in compliance with HUD requirements and supports the goals, objectives and strategies of the 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan and the CARES Act. None of the proposed activities will cause people to be displaced.

This reservation of funds is pending satisfactory completion of the NEPA/Part 58 environmental review.
