



Athletes are encouraged to wear their Senior Games T-Shirts and medals from previous years. This year's novelty events will include Bowling Pin Throw, Nail Driving Contest and Water Balloon Toss. Fees for these events are also included in your Senior Games registration fee; however you must be pre-registered to participate. Bring a lawn chair.

## **Divisions**

Age 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, and 85 and over. Divisions may be combined depending on the event and/or event participation.

Your competing age will be your age as of January 10, 2017.

There will be no separate age divisions for Water Balloon Toss.

Open division means there will be no separate age group or gender.

**We reserve the right to cancel or combine age groups when doing brackets in any event due to insufficient entries or other conditions. Decisions regarding age division and competition are left to the discretion of the event supervisor.**

## **Cancellations/Postponements**

In the event of inclement weather, insufficient registration or other unusual circumstances, the Recreation Division reserves the right to cancel or reschedule events. Call the Parks and Recreation Office at 373-5200, to confirm if weather looks uncertain. **Last participants to arrive for Cribbage, Euchre and Pinochle may not be able to participate based on number of participants.**

## **Event Schedule**

You must be present and ready to begin at the starting time of your event. Events will not be delayed for latecomers. Those planning to compete in multiple events should note the event schedule for possible conflicts. No event will be delayed to convenience a conflicting schedule. Do not select events that are held consecutively as we cannot guarantee the ending time of any event. Some events are long. We encourage you to bring your lunch and/or snacks when concessions are not available.

## **Fees/Refunds**

A \$10.00 participation fee will be charged to each participant, which covers the overall administrative costs of the games and includes admission to the Opening Ceremonies, Picnic Lunch, and our Novelty Events (Bowling Pin Throw, Water Balloon Toss, and Nail Driving Contests). This fee also includes the Closing Ceremonies luncheon and entertainment. Extra luncheon tickets may be purchased at the Parks and Recreation Office for \$5.00 each. Certain events require on-site fees. On-site fees are listed in the event information/descriptions sections. **Refunds will not be made unless an event is cancelled.**

## **Registration Information**

1. In addition to the Senior Games registration fee, all events will cost \$5.00 per event entered.
2. Additional on-site fees are as follows and payable at the event. Bowling lane fee is \$6.00 with shoe rental included; and \$18.00 or \$26.00 with cart at Desert Hills Par 3.
3. Parks and Recreation accepts American Express, Master Card, Visa, and Discover Card.
4. Refunds will not be made unless an event is cancelled.
5. **All events require a minimum five (5) business days advance registration or until event is full. The registration deadline is listed under each event. No on-site registration will be taken.**
6. Bocce Doubles Mixed, Bocce Doubles Men's, Bocce Doubles Women's, Tennis Doubles, Tennis Doubles Mixed, Pool Shooting Doubles Men's, Pool Shooting Doubles Women's, Pool Shooting Doubles Mixed, Pickleball Doubles Mixed, Pickleball Doubles Men's, and Pickleball Doubles Women's **require that participants register as partners or teams. Can only play on one team in each event.**

## **Awards**


Medallions will be awarded to gold, silver, and bronze medalists in each division for every event. Awards will be presented at the completion of each event, unless noted otherwise.

## **Arizona Senior Olympics History**

In Arizona, Senior Olympics began in 1982. During the first two years (1982-1983), these games were titled "City Games", and held in Phoenix. In 1984, the name "Arizona Senior Olympics" was born. Today, "Arizona Senior Olympics" is the recognized State Championships held annually during late February or early March. The City of Phoenix still hosts and coordinates the games with partnership and assistance from the cities of Glendale, Mesa, Peoria, Scottsdale, and Tempe. Senior Olympics "Nationals" were started in St. Louis, Missouri in 1987. Today, the National Championships are held every other year. Senior Games began in Yuma in 1985. We look forward to our 33rd Annual Senior Olympics Games.

Participants may arrive at 8:30 a.m. to allow for practice time. Each participant will total 30 free throws in the **Free Throw** competition from 12 or 15 feet (their choice). First player to shoot will take 10 shots, next player taking 10, and so on. Repeat in same order during the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of 10 free throws. After two rounds (20 free throws), players will shoot in order

of their standings, with the highest score shooting last. Winner will be the most made attempts of 30.

**Long Shot** players will take 3 shots from 5 designated spots on the floor. Each shot carries a different point value. The highest score from all 15 attempts will be the winner.

In case of a tie, players will take one additional shot from each station, best of 5 made shall be the winner. Regulation size basketballs (men) and intermediate or regulation size basketballs (women) will be utilized. **Women and Men 80+ will shoot from a closer distance than the men.** Once the ball has been released from the hand, players' feet may cross the designated station line, but not touch down until release is complete. No time limit on this event.

Double elimination or round robin format based on number registered will be played. Two boards will be placed 20 feet apart, from front of board to front of board. Player who starts will be decided by the flip of a coin. Game winner reaches 40 points. A tie will warrant a sudden death playoff toss. Players must stand to the side of the board when throwing, but must not cross in front of board. Player consecutively throws 4 bags scoring 1 point if bean bag stays on the board and 3 points if bean bag falls in the hole then second thrower will throw 4 bags. Higher scorer last round goes first. If bean bag is on the edge of board, player must lift the front of the board off the floor to see if bag remains on board. If bag falls off, there is no score. Bag may bounce onto the board. The winner will be declared at total of 40 points.

**Note: Bring a lawn chair. Participants must register with a partner. Teams will be placed in specific age divisions based on the actual age of the youngest player on that particular team. Rule coverage will be 15 minutes before your scheduled time.**

The object is to score the most points by ending each round with your color balls closest to the Pallino (point ball). Toss of a coin determines who will play first. To start the game, one Team/Person throws the Pallino at least halfway down the designated playing area. The same person who tossed the Pallino then throws one ball trying to get it as close to the Pallino as possible. Team Two then throws, trying to get a ball closer to the Pallino than Team One. If Team Two gets closer, then it is Team One's turn. If Team Two's ball does not come closer then they continue to throw until they get closer to the Pallino than Team One or until they run out of balls. Then Team One throws their balls. You can knock your opponent's balls away from the Pallino to increase your score. Tournament format determined by the number of entries. Games will be to 12 points. Concession available.

Four-handed Cribbage will be played. Participants will play as a group; however, medals will be awarded according to age and gender. Ten games will be played with a regular 52-card deck. Cards rank from K-highest to A-lowest. Each player is dealt 5 cards and 1 card is put in the crib. Dealer of the first game is determined by cutting of cards, lowest card deals. Dealers of next games will be the “B” player. Opponents must sign score sheets. Total score of all games played determines winners. If there are scoring ties at the end of a game, cutting of the cards will determine table reassignments with the high card moving. Partners will consist of one “A” player and one “B” player. After 4 hands have been played, the “A” winner advances to next highest table, “B” winner advances to next lowest table, and losers stay at the same table; however, players change seats as to not have same partner. Please lay table number down when all are finished. Players change tables after all tables have finished. If possible, players are encouraged to bring pegboards to event. Waiting list established to even tables. A 40-minute time limit will be in effect.

The total of all points scored will seed all participants into a double elimination tournament. During the double elimination each participant will toss 12 darts, 3 tosses per round. The top seed in each match will toss last. For preliminary purposes, ties will be broken by the highest points tallied during any one round. During elimination play, a tie will warrant sudden death single dart playoff. Steel or soft tips allowed. You may cross throwing line once dart is thrown. Participants may use their own darts.

Interested in trying something new? Game is played much like traditional golf, however in lieu of clubs and balls, players throw discs into small metal basket that are about waist high. Virtually all of the same rules of traditional golf are followed including golf etiquette; meaning the object of game is to acquire the lowest score at each basket (lowest overall scores wins). As this is the inaugural year for disc golf in the City of Yuma Senior Games program, it will be offered “FREE” to registered senior games participants as an exhibition activity with the goal of introducing event to participants and as a prospective event in the future games.

Last card of the pack is turned up. When "turn up" card is accepted play begins. No combination of walking and running will be allowed. A walker who is, in the opinion of the supervisor, not adhering to walking but trying to advance to running will be warned once. Continuation of this unfair advantage will disqualify the non-competitor from medal consideration.

If a participant goes over the line prior to or before the release or makes contact with the ball, they will be penalized five (5) feet. 
